BACKGROUND OF LIFEPORT CHARITY

LifePort Sweden has been the regular donor to SMILES since 2009 when SMILES was just founded by passionate Nepalese Engineering students. The Co-Founder of SMILES, Mrs. Ellinor Broms in Sweden made the collaboration become possible. The collaboration since 2009 till now has contributed a lot in the activities that SMILES is doing. Starting from toilets, Solar Panels and computer labs, we have recently provided white boards and kitchen utensils to rural schools with LifePort support. LifePort CEO, Mr. Gabor Kovacs himself managed a way to travel to our SMILES village Kalimati in Sindhuli District of Nepal.

SMILES received total of SEK 8000 on 27th September 2013. While working on the field, some of the priority mentioned in the budget weren't feasible to action while some of the really important tasks were done. These are the lists of activities that were done with support from Lifeport Charity 2013.

1. White-Boards, Markers, Duster, ink to a rural school

Chalk dust has been proven harmful to both teachers and students health. So, we want to replace this traditional Black-board/Chalk with safe White-Board/Marker system. With Support from Lifeport Charity, SMILES distributed 8 sets of white boards, Duster, Marker and Ink to Binayak Lower Secondary School in Kalimati Village of Sindhuli on Nov 8 2013.

2. Toilet Construction:

SMILES had proposed only one toilet for Kalimati Village. But we have already built one toilet (16th) and the next which is 17th one is under construction. We had expected it to be completed by now but due to monsoon in Nepal, we haven't got report of its completion.

3. Kitchen Utensils in School

With LifePort Charity, it was possible to provide Kitchen Resource to Binayak Lower Secondary School. Now, the problem of teachers going to their home at Lunch time has been solved. This has helped students to get timely class from their teachers.






Fig: Kitchen Material Distribution Program on Binayak Lower Secondary School
